This bibliography is a result of my study in Malaysia at the Central Library of University of Malaya in Kuala Lumpur from March 1987 to March 1989.

I am very much thankful to Mrs. Khoo Siew Mun, the Chief Librarian of U. M., who accepted me as the first visiting librarian to the Library. I also express my sincere thanks to the other staff who extended kind cooperation to me.

As this bibliography focuses on economic and social development in Malaysia since the implementation of New Economic Policy, materials published before 1970s are not included. Materials on specific industries such as agriculture, manufacturing industries are also excluded in this sense.

I hope this bibliography will be helpful to the people who are interested in this field.
