Some parts of this study were already published elsewhere. Chapter 1 is largely based on "An Overview of Thai Economic Growth in the Post-War Period" in Wonghanchao and Ikemoto [69]. The first half of chapters 2, 3, and 4 are an updated revision of "Income Inequality and Regional Disparity in Thailand, 1962-81" published in *The Developing Economies*, vol. 25, no. 3, (September 1987), which is itself a revised edition of Limskul and Ikemoto [34].
