## PREFACE

In the last several decades, many countries in the Asia-Pacific region proved their high industrial capacity to sustain a stable economic growth under the continuously changing environment. In particular, after the Plaza Agreement in 1985, the swift appreciation of Japanese yen has driven many Japanese investors to relocate their industrial sites to the neighbouring countries, leading to the drastic change in industrial constellation within the region. The technological change that came about, therefore, has become a major analytical focus of academic researchers and policy planners.

On this account, the National Economic and Social Development Board, Thailand, and Institute of Developing Economies, Japan, launched in 1993 for a joint research project on the compilation of *the 1990 International Input-Output Table, Thailand-Japan*. In principle, the table succeeds for the style and format to its predecessor, *the 1985 International Input-Output Table, Thailand-Japan*, enabling the time-series analysis of technological change that took place between 1985 and 1990.

It is our pleasure here to release *the 1990 International Input-Output Table, Thailand-Japan*, to be widely used as a powerful analytical tool serving for the public interest.
